Course Goal:

This course is designed to teach presentation skills and familiarize students with some current topics in physics and astronomy.

Course Content:

During the semester, each student will make 3 presentations. They are:

- 1.) a sample slide,
- 2.) a 20 minute "short talk about a specific question", and
- 3.) a 40 minute talk about a research article in a professional journal (i.e., a "journal club" presentation).

Getting Feedback Before Your Journal Club Presentation:

So that I can warn you away from papers that would be difficult to give journal club talks on and so that I can try to head off potential problems with your journal club presentations, send me the reference to your journal club paper at least 14 days before your scheduled talk and send or show me a complete rough draft of your journal club presentation at least 3 days before your scheduled talk.

Attendance and Participation:

Part of taking this class is being a good audience for other students' talks. So, if there are any talks scheduled for a given day, then you should come to the class, pay attention, be respectful of the speaker(s), and, ask at least 1 question per presentation. You will also be asked to write comments about other students' presentations. Try to be constructive, insightful, and useful.
